## Language Arts Literacy

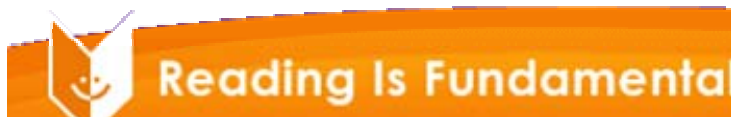
