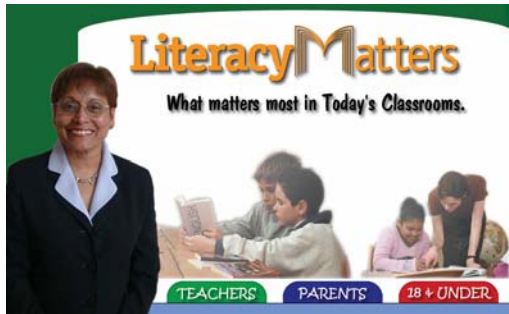
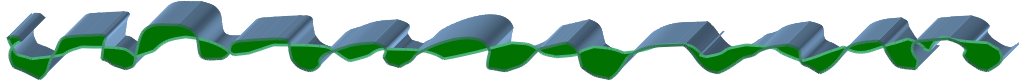

## Reading Comprehension

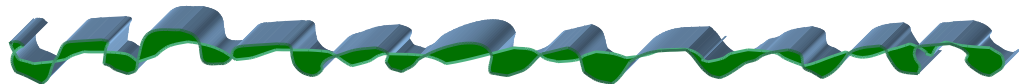
