Dear Parents and Guardians,

It's been a rough week with all of the snow we have had. Somehow this week seemed longer than normal. I would just like to update you on our status regarding Covid-19.

We currently have 30 students quarantined in the district. There are 8 positive students. Of those eight, only four are new positives for this week. There are two students who are out because they were close contacts of someone who was positive or symptomatic and two other students are symptomatic and getting a test. The rest of the students were on the list the week before. There are 3 new teachers who were quarantining this week.

Covid-19 quarantines continues to be a challenge for us to staff the buildings. It is imperative that if your child is symptomatic, he or she should remain home. It's Super Bowl weekend and while most of us will be watching the game at home with our immediate families, I read that it is estimated that 25% of football fans will still be gathering with friends or relatives to watch the game. Please bear in mind that many people who are positive for Covid-19 are asymptomatic or haven't shown symptoms yet, so they go to a gathering. It's the next day when people find out that they were exposed to someone who is now sick. If you do choose to go to a Super Bowl party, please consider quarantining your child immediately after the game. Contact the building principal and they will help to make arrangements for your child to learn remotely.
