You may have heard that the CDC has reduced the required distance for students to 3 feet. There are additional factors that were included, especially for the middle and high school levels. We are proceeding with our plans as we were able to make these changes prior to this new information.

For grades 7 & 8, the bigger issue is their schedule, not the distance and we are continuing to put our best efforts into resolving that challenge. If we are able to overcome the scheduling challenges, I will announce that at the earliest opportunity, but the CDC's new guidance won't impact that.

We are also planning to keep as much distance between our students as possible. While we can go as close as 3 feet, we are keeping as much distance as possible between our students; however, if we can use this to keep more students with their existing teacher, we may reduce that
