Dear Parents/Guardians:

All new Lincoln Park residents planning to enroll or stay enrolled in Boonton High School must visit the Lincoln Park Board of Education office to fill out paperwork regarding residency. Students may only enroll in Boonton High School, whose parent(s)/legal guardian(s) reside within Lincoln Park.

Please be aware that N.J.S.A. 18A:38-1 and N.J.A.C. 6A:22 require that a free public education be provided to students between the ages of 5 and 20. In order to help us determine your student's eligibility to attend school in this district in accordance with New Jersey law, please bring the following when visiting the office:

- Property tax bills, deeds, contracts of sale, leases, mortgages, signed letters from landlords and other evidence of property ownership, tenancy or residency;
- Birth certificate of child(ren) being registered;
- Court orders, State agency agreements and other evidence of court or agency placements or directives for child(ren), if applicable.

If your address should change throughout the year, it is your responsibility to inform Boonton High School. Residence verification is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardian(s). If it is determined that any information has been falsified or that the enrollment of any student is in violation of the Lincoln Park Board of Education policy, the following actions may be taken:

- a) The student shall be immediately withdrawn from school;
- b) The parent(s)/guardian(s) shall be charged tuition for the period of the violation.
